### Current News

The March Club meeting will be held at the flying field. The meeting will be on March 18, 2017 at 10:30 am. The meeting will be canceled if there is rain on that day. The monthly meetings will be themed meetings. The upcoming March meeting will be Cubs or Similar. Bring any type of plane that can represent a Cub.

We currently have a policy that a non-member can fly at the field up to three times (provided they are not flying at a sanctioned event). After that, the non member must join the club prior to further flying at the field. This policy was discussed at the meeting. A suggested option is to allow guests to be able to fly more than three times if they are from a distance of 100 miles or more. We will be discussing this further during the March meeting. Another thought is to limit the number of flying guests to 2 per member.

Also at no time shall a non-member be on site without a current club member with them. The guests/visitors must leave the field with the last club member as he leaves the field. Also, any visitor who wants to fly must get permission from any member at the field.

We will be having a field clean up day a week before the swap meet at the field. This will be on Saturday March 18, 2017. This will be mostly a mowing, spraying, and trimming day.

The 21st annual swap meet will be held on March 25, 2017 starting at 7:30 am. See events on the web site for the flyer with more information.
